MOVING

The beginning of 2023 has been busy with many new refugee and asylumseeking families settling in the Austin area. There have been approximately 15-20 new families who have requested help moving to their new apartments, who need many items for their new empty apartments, and who are looking for general assistance settling into their new community. We are so grateful for our wonderful volunteers who continue to be generous in sharing needed items, who assist with delivery of items, and who have helped several families move around the greater Austin area.



TRANSPORTATION

As our friends settle into their new community, we are also assisting them to take their next steps to independence by helping them to find jobs, and by showing them how to use the bus system to get to their new employment sites. We are so grateful for the response of our volunteer community who step forward to help with these one-time opportunities to assist our friends with appointments and transportation needs.

YOUTH MENTORSHIP

Youth mentorship is another area that continues to be an area of great need, and engagement with the youth refugee and asylum-seeker community is a priority. Alliance has begun to work with a partner who is exploring starting a charter school for refugee teens. Stay tuned for progress on this exciting project.
