Passage: Luke 2:41–52

1. Read the Passage Aloud

Take turns reading the passage slowly, letting everyone hear the story of Jesus as a 12-year-old in the temple.

Bible Study Using OIA

Observation — What does the text say?

- What yearly tradition brought Jesus' family to Jerusalem?
- How long was Jesus separated from His parents before they found Him?
- Where did they eventually find Him, and what was He doing?
- How did the teachers in the temple react to Him?
- What did Jesus say when Mary asked why He stayed behind?
- How does the passage end, and what do we learn about Jesus' growth?

Interpretation — What does the text mean?

- What does this story reveal about Jesus' awareness of His identity and mission, even at a young age?
- How does Jesus' response show the priority of God's will over even good things like family expectations?
- Why do you think Luke included the detail that Jesus "grew in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and man"?
- What does this passage teach us about spiritual maturity and personal growth?
- How does this connect to the message theme of *Grown* that growth is intentional and rooted in being with the Father?

Application — How should we respond?

Personal

- In what area of your life do you sense God calling you to grow in wisdom, character, or spiritual maturity?
- In what ways are you sensing God calling you to get involved in this season?
- Are you intentionally creating space to be "in the Father's house" (spiritually speaking) through prayer, Scripture, worship, and coming on Sundays?

Relational

- How can your growth in Christ positively influence your relationships with others?
- Are there people in your life you can invite into your own growth journey or help them in theirs?

 How is God guiding you to help you love others, serve others, bring justice to others, bring hope to others, or share your faith with others?

Practical Step

- Choose one specific habit or practice this week to grow in your relationship with God — for example, set a daily time for prayer, memorize a verse, or read a chapter of Scripture each day.
- Join in Pray First and pray daily for teachers and school staff.
 If you are a parent, you can give your kids' teachers a prayer card so they can pick it up and commit as a family to pray for your teachers!
