LOOK UP

Read Acts 19:1-20

Observe: What does the text say?

- What are the different responses to Jesus in this passage?
- What happens to the sons of Sceva and why?
- How do the people respond after witnessing God's power?

Interpret: What does this passage mean?

- Why do you think the sons of Sceva failed while Paul had spiritual authority?
- What's the difference between knowing *about* Jesus and having a *relationship* with Jesus?
- What does this passage teach you about God? About humanity?

Apply: How do I live in response to this passage?

Rate Yourself (0–10):

- **Following Jesus**
- **Being changed by Jesus**
- **Committed to the mission of Jesus**

Identifying Idols:

- What might be competing with Jesus for first place in your life?
- What might God be asking you to surrender this week?
